## **GUIDELINES FOR PLACING ADVERTISING SIGNS ON BARRINGTON GREEN**

The Trustee is keen to see Barrington Green used as much as possible, and appreciates that this may include placing advertising signs out on the Green. Here are some notes to help you if you are considering doing so.

Barrington Green is a registered Village Green, and as such the residents can reasonably expect the Trustee to look after both the grounds and the appearance.

With an increase in signs appearing on the Green, the Trustee has revisited its right and obligations to monitor the use of signs and is now asking for companies and other third parties to seek the permission of the Trustee of the Green Charity. This is done by contacting the Clerk in the first instance. Tell us the period of time required for the sign to be on the Green, and the details of the sign itself.

Anyone wishing to use the Green must show the Green Charity that they have Public Liability insurance covering the advertising sign in excess of £3 million in each and every claim.

Any damage to the Green caused by the sign must be remedied by the company as the Green Charity has no staff to undertake such work.

Barrington Green has to be maintained. The only income the Green Charity has annually for such maintenance is by making a charge for the use of the Green. The minimum contribution to the Charity is £25.00, but the amount would depend upon the intended usage. Charities are exempt.

Estate Agency and contractor signs are not permitted to be placed on Barrington Green
