Crimes reported for Barrington from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015 – 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016

Total 20 compared to 2014-2015 which was 22 recorded.

So well done to all those who have assisted us in reporting suspicious behaviour and increasing the chance of catching possible offenders.

The crimes received are;-

4 x Theft from Motor vehicles

1 x Theft of a pedal cycle

3 x Burglary other than a dwelling

2 x Criminal damage

6 x Theft from shed's

1 x Theft from shops / stalls

3 x Theft if not classified elsewhere

Please continue to look after yourself and neighbours by continuing to report anything suspicious. And thank you for the crime prevention evenings for shed burglary's as this crime seemed to dwindle and stop afterwards.
