

The Green Charity - Chairman's Report 2015-2016

The Trustee held six formal meetings during the year. Most of its activities are related to the maintenance, appearance and preservation of the Green. The Green is used for many different activities including vintage car displays, cricket and football. Tony Fletcher was elected as Chairman of the Trustee.

Repair works to the Permitted Way roadways were carried out during the year, costing £6,916. Other works cost an additional £4,600. The Green Charity thanks John Cobb & Sons for the high standard of their work.

Based on advice from the District Auditor new fee levels have been established for the period September 2015 - August 2019. A study into variable fee levels as a consequence of different distances of roadway used for access was abandoned as it proved too complex.

Heslerton Green area is now cut by the Parish Council but any other remedial work will continue as required.

The Green Charity provided three flower beds on the Green at the corner of Glebe Road to enhance the area. Volunteers are maintaining them. The cost of the beds and the plants was £2,144.

Attached to this report is a copy of the Audited Accounts for the year 2014-2015 and the Draft Accounts for the year 2015-2016. The Trustee thanks Simon Lake for auditing these accounts.
