



- 5 Planning matters : SCDC Planning decisions continued**
- 5.2.2 **S/1080/10/CW: Barrington Quarry Haslingfield Road: CEMEX UK Operations** **Pending**  
**Importation, by rail, of suitable restoration material, over a period of 5 years, to partially infill an existing quarry void and provide for the restoration of the western and north-western areas of Barrington Quarry to a combination of agriculture and nature conservation after-uses, and all associated works including railway refurbishment and the retention and continued use of existing weighbridge, office and workshop.**
- 5.2.3 **S/1609/10: 36 High Street: Mr C Taylor: Erection of a new ecological dwelling with carport and store, including new access driveway and turning area** **Pending**
- 5.2.4 **S/1629/10: 4 Challis Close: Mr K Cooper for Mr Mrs Bridges: Front extension, single storey, forming wet room and bay window to existing lounge.** **Approved**
- 5.2.5 **S/1693/10: 30 Shepreth Road: Mrs E Galpin: Replace the existing flat roofed structure with a larger pitched roof structure and a replacement front entrance porch.** **Pending**

- 5.3 **Parish Council Planning decisions:**
- 5.3.1 **S/1947: 48 West Green: Dr Mrs Tew:** **Approve**  
**Replace 11 windows in listed building with double glazed windows**  
 The Parish Council agrees with the installation of double glazing in listed buildings provided that it meets with the style of the building
- 5.3.2 **S/2098/10: Trinity Farm 21 Orwell Road: Mr Mrs P Carey:** **Approve**  
**Extension to dwellinghouse, including demolition of existing extension**
- 5.4 **Tree works application within a Conservation Area : None**
- 6 South Cambridgeshire District Council**
- 6.1 District Cllr David Bird mentioned the traffic control proposals for Cambridge.
- 6.2 **BT telephone boxes:** No further information available. **ADVW**
- 6.3 The South Cambridgeshire Village Services & Facilities Study for Barrington had been completed.
- 7 Cambridgeshire County Council**
- 7.1 County Cllr Kindersley was unable to attend the meeting. His report had been circulated to Councillors prior to the Meeting.
- 7.2 **Salt bins:** The five new salt bins were in place before Christmas, and the salt had been invaluable in recent weeks. The extremely low temperatures below 5°C had frozen the salt. On the proposal of Cllr Fletcher, it was agreed to purchase a further salt bin to be placed in Malthouse Way parking area. **AF/MG**
- 7.3 **Road between Haslingfield and Barton villages:** The Parish Council had written to the County Council protesting strongly against the decision not to provide winter gritting on this road. No reply or acknowledgement had been received. A petition containing signatures collected at Barrington Stores likewise protesting against the decision had been forwarded to County Cllr Kindersley. **SK AF/MG**
- 7.4 **T-junction in Shepreth at Village Hall and Meldreth Road:** Councillors had expressed their concern about the lack of appropriate road junction Stop markings for vehicles leaving Meldreth Road and in particular those vehicles turning right without stopping. The problem for traffic approaching from Barrington was much worse if vehicles were parked outside the Village Hall. The County Council were willing to renew the white road markings, after April in the new financial year. **AF/SK**
- 7.5 **Parish Paths Partnership:** Cllr Day tabled a paper setting out the work completed during 2010 on the Village Footpaths, together with an estimate of work and costs for 2011. There was general agreement that the Parish Council would continue to give financial support to maintaining the Footpaths supplementing the County Council annual grant. **AF/AD**
- 7.6 **Raised walkway adjacent Shepreth Road bridge:** The Parish Council was concerned about the overgrowth of weeds surrounding the walkway and the rotting leaves under foot. It was agreed to request the County Council for a discussion on the way forward. **SK/MG**

A request had been sent to the landowner to carry out repairs to the fence. Response awaited.
